Hi Gert; Price for the reamer, dies and gauges would be \$275.00 plus shipping – I will need your postal code for shipping costs. I also have 40 RWS .404J fully formed and once fired .375 Canadian cases. This brass is the best I ever used for the Imperial and Canadian cartridges – very tough and long lasting. Cost of the 40 cases will be \$80.00. I should mention you need a #26 RCS shell holder for your loading press for these RWS cases which I will include if you want the cases.
